This also gives me opportunity to reconnect with returning students as well as introduce myself to new students.

When appropriate, I will post or send home information that I think would be beneficial to families of our school and community to help keep us all informed of the latest health information available.

I will also be posting to the website several information fact sheets on some of the more common afflictions seen in school age children. I also post Monthly Health observances for your information. If you need any further information, or help finding it, please call the health office and Iøl do what I can to help. Starting in October, as time allows, I will be doing routine health screenings for vision and hearing. We also try to have the Lions Club come yearly for vision and the Monadnock Healthy Teeth to Toes program comes for oral health education and dental screenings every year as well.
