- **JIHD** Student Interviews and Interrogation: add parent must be notified when interrogated by law enforcement
- **JKB** Detention of Students: Remove "May" replace "shall" (parents will be responsibly for transportation of after hour detention
- **JLCA** Physical Examination of Students: Remove "Religious" replace "Moral Objection", remove third paragraph
- JLCB Immunization of Students: Remove "Religious" replace "Moral Objection"
- JLI Safety Program: Add "policy shall be reviewed annually prior to the start of the school year"
