CLERK OF THE DISTRICT
The Clerk of the District is an elected official, where he/she is appointed by the board. The Clerk shall keep a true record of each District meeting and make any reports to the State of New Hampshire as may be required and shall carry out duties as required by law.
TREASURER
The Treasurer of the District shall be elected and shall not be a member of the School Board. He/She shall receive such remuneration as the District may determine and perform such duties pertaining to the fiscal affairs of the School District as outlined in the New Hampshire statutes relating to public schools.
A Deputy Treasurer may be appointed by the Treasurer subject to the approval of the Board.
