The Superintendent in conjunction with the Principal or designee will prepare or provide safety information for distribution to students regarding protecting themselves from abuse, abduction or exploitation. The school district's K-8 health curriculum will reflect student safety issues and how children can best protect themselves. School officials may ask their police liaison officer or local law enforcement officials for assistance in providing instruction to staff and/or students.
