JRC - RELEASE OF STUDENT INFORMATION

Category O See also <u>JRA</u>

It is the policy of the Board to not release student directory information to members of the public. Requests from members of the public for student directory information will be denied.

Directory information means:

Students' name, address, date of birth, dates of enrollment

Parents'/guardians' name and address

Students' grade level

Students' participation in recognized school activities

Weight and height of members of athletic teams

Students' diplomas, certificates, awards and honors received

The intent of this policy is to address only requests for such information from members of the public. This policy is not intended to prohibit the release of student directory information in all situations. Directory information may be disclosed in school year books, athletic programs, student newspapers, recognitions of achievement, and other situations or requests, to be determined and authorized by the Superintendent. Additionally, nothing in this policy shall prohibit the disclosure of student directory information to duly recognized and authorized school-related organizations (Parent-Teacher Organizations, Booster Clubs, etc.)

The Board will comply with all state and federal laws regarding the disclosure of student information, as expressed in Policy JRA.
