With the recent rise in viral and or bacterial infections noted in our area, we feel it is necessary to be proactive in ways to educate and eradicate. We have had several students out for 4-5 days with symptoms including but not limited to: fever, sore throat, cough and stomach upset. Our school has taken several precautionary measures to ensure the safety and health of our children during these times of illness.

In accordance with New Hampshire Department of Health and Human services, we have advocated for any student with symptoms of abdominal illness or a fever to stay home until 24 hours after the fever/illness breaks, or 24 hours after antibiotics have been started. We have taken proactive measures in the disinfection of our school. We will also continue to educate the children on hand washing, and cough and sneeze hygiene etiquette whenever possible.
