Other Important Information:

- At this point we plan to start the year in the Blue Phase based on the information we have right now (8/16/2021). You will be notified if there is a change to the phase.
- We have maintained many layers of mitigating strategies to reduce the chances of COVID entering the building.
- The mitigating strategies have been updated based on what we have learned over the last 18 months of the pandemic and how it impacted schools.
- The number 1 mitigating strategy is to stay home when ill! We will be asking for your help with this. Please DO NOT send your child to school with any illness/symptoms. Please contact Nurse Carrier to discuss symptoms. In the midst of a pandemic there is no such thing as "it's just a

cold". Everything will continue to be treated as COVID until we have another explanation for the illness or a negative COVID test (rapid or PCR).

- We are not sure of how the variants will impact us at the school and these strategies may need to change as we learn more.
- Masks will be optional in the Blue Phase, both inside and outside. NOTE: There may be times that the students will be encouraged to wear a mask during the Blue Phase if they will be participating in an activity that would require them to have close contact (less than 3 feet) for a significant amount of time (15 min or more). This will be at the discretion of the staff.
- Please provide a mask for your child to keep at school. We do have disposable masks at the school for those students that may not have their own from home.
- Masks MUST be worn on the school bus at ALL TIMES.
- If a student or staff member is found to be a close community contact to a COVID positive person they will need to self observe and follow NH DHHS guidelines to protect others i.e. masking, testing
